Please note there is no formal "application" document, your application will consist of information you provide as requested below. Include a cover page with your packet, which should include the following information: Bank of Colorado Application, your name, mailing address, home or cell phone number, email address, name of High School you attend, your High School Counselor's name and his or her contact phone number and email.

On additional sheets of paper, please address the following bullet points by listing the statement, followed by your answer. Please do not use more than one page per answer.

- Identify your career goals and why you have chosen this area(s) of study. What college do you plan to attend, why did you select it, and what will you major in (if known)?
- List your academic honors and/or scholastic standing. Include a copy of your official High School transcript with your application.
- Describe the extracurricular school activities you have been involved in, followed by a description of activities outside of school that you have been associated with during your High School years.
- Tell us something about yourself that you have not touched on in the bullet points above. What qualifies you to be awarded the Bank of Colorado Scholarship? Do not skip this portion, as it is a crucial part of your application.

Please do not send your application in a binder or folder. Make sure you have included your transcript and college acceptance letter with your application. Incomplete applications may be disqualified. Please make sure your application is received by the Yuma branch of Bank of Colorado no later than April 1, 2026.
